

Mubarak hopes Nile Basin countries agreement to materialize

Egyptian President Mohamed Hosni Mubarak received on Tuesday Tanzanian Vice President Ali Mohammed Shin

Egyptian president voiced hope that the Nile Basin Countries would finalize an agreement soon.
